
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
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

Newcastle's First Soccer Team

The first ever soccer game in Newcastle was played by the Minmi Rangers in 1885. A field was marked out at what is now Lambton Park. The match, which ended in a 2-2 draw, attracted about t 600 spectators. A plaque at Lambton Park commemorates the game, which was between South Lambton (Hamilton and other areas) and North Lambton (Minmi Rangers). 


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
