<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child's homework is not completed. • Child's homework is completed but not on time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Language, memory, attention, executive function difficulty. • Social issues. There may be problems at home in relationships and/or behaviour management. • Child may have a newly acquired problem with reading and spelling. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Generally minimise amount and difficulty level of homework early in the return to school. • Provide extra time to complete homework. • Reduce the amount of homework. • Clarify with student what homework needs to be completed. • Utilise a dairy or other memory device as a prompt to remember to do homework. • Encourage parent input.
