What you might see	What this could mean	Strategies
<ul> <li>Child's homework is not completed.</li> <li>Child's homework is completed but not on time.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Language, memory, attention, executive function difficulty.</li> <li>Social issues. There may be problems at home in relationships and/or behaviour management.</li> <li>Child may have a newly acquired problem with reading and spelling.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Generally minimise amount and difficulty level of homework early in the return to school.</li> <li>Provide extra time to complete homework.</li> <li>Reduce the amount of homework.</li> <li>Clarify with student what homework needs to be completed.</li> <li>Utilise a dairy or other memory device as a prompt to remember to do homework.</li> <li>Encourage parent input.</li> </ul>
